The fresh food is donated by restaurants and stores. This job is weekly throughout the year. □ Community Ticketing – This person helps choose dates for Asbury nights at DU sporting events and organizes selling tickets for the events. They also coordinate ticket sales for the Pearl Wine Event. □ Dining Out – Help organize dining out events by scheduling dates at participating restaurants and promoting through the Deets platform, shirt stickers and social media reminders. □ **Equity Committee** – The equity committee meets every other month to support school-wide efforts around community, inclusivity, and equitable outcomes. □ **Garden Support**– This team assists Ms. Vieau and the students in the Garden Club with spring planting, summer garden care/watering, and the after school Farmer's Market in the fall. □ **Library** – Shelve books and complete tasks to help the library as needed.
