- Return to Remote Staffing
  - Staffing structure update
    - Continue to support grade level relationships with staff in case of a switch back to in person
    - Use of adults in building to support lunch/recess
- k/1 remote student support
  - Challenges for teaching remote and in person at the same time
  - Existing teacher
  - Less disruptive to kids to add an additional digital teacher
  - 2nd grade feels like they are good with current supports but need more small group support
  - Online kids were more asynchronous
  - Communication to families clearly lays out how things are the same and how it may be different
    - Courtney Waring shares it is helping with the teacher and the kids
  - Remote students feel connected again
    - Planning with teams
    - Share lessons
- 3-5 support
  - Learning center: limited amount of student in person
  - District priorities
