Treasurer's Report

Treasurer Jenny Eno reviewed the Proposed Budget in great detail. The projected budget reflects 136k incoming and 140k outgoing with a difference of - \$ 4500. The PTSO has money available in our Savings account, should we need to pull anything from that account. Profit/Loss report reviewed as well. Updates to Bylaws were few-updates to names & dates. We added the Sustainability Committee and we removed the Box Tops. Email will go out to all PTSO members tomorrow to vote on the Budget & Bylaws. The deadline for the vote is Friday at 5pm.

PTSO Odds & Ends

Carnival- We made \$ 5949.11 total from Carnival. Revenue was \$ 7576 and expenses were \$ 1626. One of the Food Trucks at Carnival donated all of the proceeds they made back to Asbury.
