#### Billing

- Beginning in August, monthly charges will be posted to your account on the 15<sup>th</sup>.
- Monthly payments are due by the 3<sup>rd</sup> of each month.
- If your family signs up for Autopay, your account will be charged on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of each month.
- A late fee for unpaid accounts will be assessed on the 8<sup>th</sup> of each month.
- Non-payment withdrawal date from program is the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month.

#### Registering for multiple sites:

Discovery Link understands that some families new to the District are still deciding which school their child will attend. Families may register their child(ren) at a maximum of TWO sites. Within one week of notification by the DPS Choice office of school assignment, parents must select which Discovery Link program their children will attend.

#### Financial Aid:

Limited financial aid is available. Scholarship applications will only be considered for families who don't otherwise qualify for CCAP. The criteria to apply for CCAP is detailed below. Please contact [discovery\\_link@dpsk12.org](mailto:discovery_link@dpsk12.org) for further information.

- Employed or self-employed and earning at least minimum wage for the hours worked, or;
- Attending high school, college for the first bachelor's degree or vocational program, or earning a GED or ESL, or;
- Currently searching for a job, or;
- Participating in Colorado Works and qualify for child care as part of their Individual Plan
